Get There by Transit

TriMet Light Rail

TriMet'sBlue and Red MAX Light Rail lines serve the Washington Park MAX station. Trains heading east to downtown and west to the Sunset Transit Center Park and Ride arrive every nine minutes.

The park is four stops from Pioneer Courthouse Square.
