Risk Management and similar career paths are often considered professional and business services industry with a stable and consistent employment growth over the next several decades.

# Job Title: Underwriter

Job Summary: An insurance underwriter assesses applications for insurance coverage and makes decisions about whether someone receives coverage based on their potential risk as a client. Insurance underwriters typically use criteria from the companies they work for to evaluate whether a customer qualifies for an insurance policy. They can also help insurance companies set policy prices by analyzing risk and offering professional recommendations.

# Job Title: Claims Adjuster / Examiner

Job Summary: A claims adjuster is an insurance professional who helps customers revise their claims according to changing life situations. Much of a claims adjuster's job involves determining how much money an insurance company is supposed to pay a client for damage or loss, typically in circumstances that involve insured property. Many claims adjusters travel to different locations to examine property damage their clients want insurance to pay for to gauge the damage and find an appropriate amount for reimbursement.

# Job Title: Claims Investigator

**Job Summary:** A claims investigator works for an insurance company to ensure customer requests for compensation are valid. They prevent fraud by examining suspicious claims and verifying facts by collaborating with private investigators. Claims investigators also analyze social media to detect suspicious client behavior.

**Job Summary:** An insurance appraiser examines property and possessions that clients want to insure to determine their value. Insurance appraisers can also use the information they collect to determine the cost of any damages or loss a client experiences. An insurance appraiser can also work closely with a claims adjuster to find an item's final value.

# Job Title: Insurance Agent

Job Summary: An insurance agent reaches out to customers to inform them about different types of insurance policies that they can purchase. Insurance agents have extensive knowledge about the policies they market and can sometimes customize insurance plans for clients seeking specific coverage. Many insurance agents work for multiple insurance agencies or brokers, but some insurance agents work for one specific insurance company.

# Job Title: Associate Actuary

**Job Summary:** An actuary is a finance professional who assesses risk. Actuaries can help insurance companies design plans they offer clients by determining the cost of potential risks that might arise. Many actuaries work for several insurance agencies or insurance brokers. Still, they can also work for the government or specialize in one specific type of coverage such as health insurance or life insurance.
